We're thrilled to share the Village of Burlington currently being an unsewered community has recently received a \$600,000 Community Projects Funding Grant following selection by U.S. Congressman Bill Foster (IL-11) and plans to use those funds to design a sanitary sewer collection and treatment system for the Village. This is just the first step, the future construction of a wastewater collection and treatment system in Burlington, estimated to cost around \$17 million.

#### **Water Billing:**

- **Water bills are due monthly.** Actual meter reads occur in March, June, September, and December. If you have any questions, please contact Deputy Clerk, Natalie Meisner 847-683-2237. You can pay your water bill online, via mail, or submit it in the drop box at the Village Hall.

#### **Moving Out?**

- **Water Stamp Required:** Get a free water stamp before your closing.
- **Final Meter Reading:** Contact us 48 hours before closing to schedule a final reading.

#### **Garage Sales**

- **Limit:** 3 per year, not exceeding 9 days total
- **Registration:** Call us at 847-683-2283 or 847-683-2237 to register

#### **ATVs/Non-Highway Vehicles**

- **Permitted Requirements:** Brakes, steering, tires, rearview mirror, "slow moving vehicle" emblem, headlights, tail lamps, and hand signals for turns.
- **Traffic Compliance:** Follow all traffic laws, no driving on sidewalks, Village streets only, and enjoy safe driving day or night.

**Building Permits Are Required For** new construction, additions, renovations, demolitions, driveways, fences, sheds, patios/decks, pools, AC/furnace, water heaters, siding, re-roofs, windows, doors, generators, and electrical/plumbing projects.

- **How to Apply:** Visit our website in the [Village Forms](#) section to create a Community Core Account and apply for permits through our inspection services with SAFEbuilt.
- **Contact Us:** For more information, call the Village Hall. Contractors and homeowners must register/apply for permits online and schedule inspections with SAFEbuilt at 847-510-4104
- **Pre-Inspections:** Get your permits before starting projects. Remember to contact J.U.L.I.E. at least 48 hours before digging at 1-800-892-0123.

**Solicitors** are required to obtain a permit from the Village Clerk. If you have any doubts, kindly ask the solicitor to show their identification and permit. If you feel suspicious or unsafe, do not hesitate to call 911 and report the incident to the Kane County Sheriff's Office.
